Details about the cycling holiday on the Romantic Road and Bavarian Lakes

Let's explore Augsburg! Centuries ago, the Fugger family of merchants transformed the city into a hub for trade and leisure. The architecture around the old town, including the Fuggerei and the town hall, among other structures, still reflects this unique past.

Next, the beautiful Wörthsee awaits your visit, followed by a journey past the Andechs monastery en route to the artistic town of Murnau. Whether it's experiencing organic farming or visiting the brewery, a stop at the Benedictine monks' is always worthwhile. The journey continues seamlessly: from the Wieskirche, a rococo jewel with its 36-meter-high tower, to the breathtaking

Neuschwanstein Castle in Füssen/Schwangau. It's no wonder why the Romantic Road earned its name. The route concludes back in Augsburg, passing through Schongau and Landsberg am Lech.

The highlights of the Romantic Road cycling holiday at a glance:


- Augsburg: The third largest city in Bavaria and has a lot to offer: in the centre of the old town, you should visit the town hall with the Golden Hall and in the immediate vicinity the Perlachturm, the Weberhaus and the cathedral. The beer garden on the old city wall "Lueginsland" and the Mediterranean-style Damenhof are great places to stop.
- Wonderful bathing opportunities in the lakes: Wörthsee, Ammersee, Staffelsee, Riegsee - the glittering treasures of the journey invite you to bathe, relax and of course have fun and action. Rent a pedal boat or, in the case of the Wörthsee, an original Venetian gondola!
- King Ludwig's fairytale castles: Neuschwanstein Castle was built from the remains of two castles in 1868 and is still considered the fairytale castle par excellence worldwide today. Directly opposite is Hohenschwangau Castle, which is also worth seeing - take a look at the royal apartments, and the castle kitchen and stroll through the castle garden.
- The wildly romantic Lech river: From Vorarlberg through the Tyrol and in Bavaria the Celts called the river "the stony one", which can still be traced back to the gravel banks today. In Landsberg, you have the opportunity to observe the power of the river on the bridges, which are still used today to generate electricity.

Worth knowing about the cycle tour along the Romantic Road to Augsburg

The tour begins with several climbs, gradually levelling out as it progresses. You'll traverse stunning cycle paths and scenic side streets. A standout highlight is tracing the footsteps of the Romans along the renowned Via Claudia Augusta, adding a special historical dimension to your

Itinerary

DAY 1

Arrival in Augsburg

DAY

2

Augsburg – Wörthsee approx. 65 km

Tour information and bike distribution. The first stage leads across lush meadows and through traditional Bavarian towns to the Ammersee. On the lake shore, cozy inns with sunny terraces and shady gardens invite you to take a rest. Continue to the Wörthsee, where the first rays of spring sunshine are enough to warm up quickly.

DAY 3

Wörthsee – Murnau approx. 60 km

Directly along the Wörthsee and Pilsensee, first to the Andechs monastery. Through the Pfaffenwinkel past original Bavarian places - the monks of the surrounding 12 monasteries gave them their current appearance. In addition to the Ammersee, the Staffelsee and the Riegsee in Murnau also offer bathing opportunities.

DAY

Murnau – Füssen/Schwangau 4

approx. 60 km

Magnificent pasture landscapes and alpine romance accompany you today on the way to Füssen/Schwangau. On the way there, the world-famous Wieskirche - the epitome of Bavarian rococo - is waiting to be visited.

DAY5

Füssen/Schwangau – Schongau approx. 50 km

King Ludwig's fairytale castles in the Königswinkel - Hohenschwangau and Neuschwanstein - and the uncovered Roman thermal baths at the valley station of the Tegelberg can be visited. Via Steingaden and Peiting along the Via Claudia Augusta full of impressions to Schongau.

DAY 6

Schongau – Landsberg/Lech approx. 35 km

Schongau - a former Bavarian border fortress - with the walkable battlements on the city wall, bears witness to the past. The magnificent view over the Lechtal gives us great expectations. Altenstadt (Romanesque vaulted basilica), Hochenfurch, Epfach (the Roman Abodiacum, Roman museum) and Vilgertshofen (baroque pilgrimage church) are places to visit before you reach Landsberg.

DAY7

Landsberg/Lech – Augsburg

approx. 45 km

The medieval town centre of Landsberg/Lech, embedded in the wild and romantic riverbed of the river of the same name, the historic town hall and the Gothic Bayerntor are sights to see. Via Kaufering along the Lech to Königsbrunn (with a length of 11 km the best-preserved section of the Via Claudia), to the old Bavarian ducal city of Friedberg and on to the Fugger city of Augsburg with the famous Fuggerei from 1516. Numerous monuments from all eras determine the cityscape.

DAY

8

Departure or tour extension

Route information

There are numerous bike paths and side streets with minimal traffic. The first three stages involve a few uphill sections suitable for cycling. The paths are primarily paved, with occasional shorter stretches on gravel paths. Starting from Füssen and continuing along the Lech, the terrain is almost entirely flat until Augsburg.
