
#### Worth knowing about the Flanders: Brussels to Bruges tour

Cities like Ghent and Antwerp have embraced cycling as a primary mode of transportation, implementing cyclist-friendly infrastructure such as bike lanes, bike-sharing programs, secure bike parking facilities, and traffic-calmed zones to prioritise cyclists' safety and convenience.

Flanders also uses a node network system, where cyclists can plan their routes using numbered nodes that connect various paths. This intuitive system allows riders to create customised routes that are easy to follow.

### Itinerary

DAY 1

Arrival in Brussels

Brussels, a lively Belgian metropolis, pulses with art, culture, and awe-inspiring architecture. From the iconic Grote Markt to the futuristic Atomium and the whimsical Manneken Pis statue, its landmarks capture the city's essence. Indulge in classic Belgian fries from stalls adorning every corner, adding a crispy delight to the vibrant cityscape.



After breakfast, explore the European capital at your leisure. Discover intriguing insights into Central Africa at the Royal Museum in Tervuren, or enjoy a tranquil stroll through the adjacent park, perhaps stopping for a picnic to energize for the upcoming kilometers. Following the historic Art City Route swiftly guides you to Leuven, a bustling university town where vibrant student life sets the tone in pedestrian-friendly zones. Continuing along the Dijle's path, you'll arrive at Mechelen, today's destination. The melodious chimes of the renowned tower bells resonate through the narrow streets, marking time up to eight times an hour.

D A Y **3** 

Mechelen – Antwerp approx. 45 km

Mechelen, a picturesque Flemish gem, boasts a treasury of heritage-protected buildings, churches, and monuments dating back to the 16th century. Following tranquil and level paths tracing the Beneden-Dijl and Nete rivers, you'll encounter the historic town of Lier, renowned not only for its delectable cuisine but also for its UNESCO-recognized beguinage and striking belfry. Your journey culminates in Antwerp, famed as a pivotal diamond trading hub. Art thrives in this port metropolis, and avid shoppers will revel in the abundance of upscale boutiques. D A Y **4** 

#### Antwerp – Dendermonde approx. 55 km

Antwerp, nestled along the Scheldt, becomes the scenic backdrop for your day's journey. Enjoy a picturesque route flanked by verdant meadows and grazing cows. Serene landscapes intermingle with charming Flemish villages, inviting several opportunities to unwind with a cup of coffee. Dendermonde, our stage destination, boasts a distinctive symbol—a colossal wooden horse—and hosts the rare Ross Bayard parade every decade, a celebration of folk traditions. As evening falls, savour a palate-pleasing experience at the myriad restaurants gracing the historic market square.

D A Y 5

**Dendermonde – Ghent** approx. 45 km

Today, your journey traces the meandering path of the Scheldt once more. Embrace carefree cycling along flat riverside paths, passing by quaint Flemish villages ideal for rejuvenating breaks. Your day culminates in Ghent, adorned with a wealth of cultural gems. The historic centre unfurls a tapestry of sights akin to strung pearls. As night falls, immerse yourself in Flanders' culinary panorama, indulging in the trendy city's diverse gastronomic delights.

DAY 6

Ghent – Kortrijk approx. 60 km

Today's stage leads you through the enchanting landscape along the river Leie. This picturesque region, with its lush greenery and expansive forests, stands as a natural paradise that has inspired countless artists. Along the way, neoclassical castles and quaint artists' villages grace the route, inviting admiration of painters' works showcased in local museums. Your destination, Kortrijk, embodies the allure of a bustling city fused with the warmth of a village. Its centre is a blend of modern architectural marvels, centuries-old cultural heritage, and vibrant creative expressions.



Kortrijk – Bruges approx. 60 km

You should not delay too much today, because Bruges awaits you at the end of the stage: arguably one of the most beautiful places in the world. The city has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is a treat for the eyes. The medieval city centre has remained practically unchanged since the 15th century. The canals guaranteed success and prosperity in the Middle Ages and made Bruges the Venice of the North. A perfect place to end your cycling tour through the historic art cities of the beautiful Flanders region!

D A Y **8** 

#### Departure from Bruges or extra nights

After breakfast, it's time to embark on your return journey. Choose between our optional cycle bus transfer to Brussels or extend your stay in Bruges for further exploration, including the possibility of a round trip to the North Sea. The choice is yours to tailor your homeward journey according to your preferences.

## **Route information**

Flanders stands as an ideal destination for cycling enthusiasts. The region boasts a superb network of cycle paths, with predominantly easy stages navigating flat terrain along dedicated paths or low-traffic side roads. Expect slightly increased traffic only when entering or leaving towns.

Following the historic Art City Route, you'll journey along rivers and canals, with wellsignposted, mostly asphalted roads ensuring a smooth ride. With an extensive local rail network, there's flexibility to shorten routes using trains if needed, making this trip familyfriendly and accommodating for children.
