

Via Alpina Bear Trek

Discover Alpine Switzerland at its most impressive

Spectacular passes, grandiose glaciers and deep gorges - on the Bear Trek in Alpine Switzerland, true mountain hikers get their money's worth. The Via Alpina leads through lush green valleys dotted with colourful flowers. The further up you hike, the deeper the gorges to the left and right of the trails become.

Of course, the three proud Swiss mountains Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau cannot be missed on the Via Alpina. Once you have left the three mountains behind you, you will finally reach the holiday resort of Adelboden-Lenk. By the way, despite the name "Bear Trek", you will probably not see any bears in the wild. Rather, the trek owes its name to that long ago time when you could still encounter wild animals.

Details about walking holidays on Switzerland's Via Alpina Bear Trek

Good mountain boots, sufficient fitness and a lot of puff - you will need these on the trekking tour on the Via Alpina in Switzerland. You will spend countless metres in altitude and hours in the fantastic mountain world. One peak follows the next and one view is more beautiful than the other.


The highlights of the Via Alpina Bear Trek walking holiday at a glance:


- **Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau:** These are the most famous peaks of the Bernese Oberland and form a striking trio visible from afar.
- **Blüemlisalphütte:** At 2,843 metres it lies, the hut on the glacier. After a strenuous climb, you deserve lunch with a magnificent view.
- Aerial cableway to Allmenalp: With the cableway you float towards the Bunderspitz. At the top, enjoy the panoramic view of the surrounding Swiss Alps.

Interesting facts about hiking on the Via Alpina Bear Trek

A hiking stage on the Via Alpina can take up to six hours. In addition, you have to be prepared for several hundred metres in altitude and about 13 kilometres of distance per day. So the tour is not for the faint-hearted. Are you a die-hard mountain enthusiast? Then get going and explore the Swiss mountains from Meiringen to Lenk.

Itinerary

DAY 1

Arrival in Meiringen

DAY 2

Meiringen – Grindelwald

approx. 14 km | 4.5 hours

By bus to Rosenlaui, from where the first hiking route via Grosse Scheidegg to Grindelwald opens, in front of the magnificent panorama of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau peaks.

DAY 3

Grindelwald – Wengen

approx. 17 km | 5.5 hours

The hiking route first takes you past the Eiger North Face up to Kleine Scheidegg. You soon leave the tourist hustle and bustle behind you and hike on easy paths to Wengen.

DAY 4

Wengen -**Griesalp/Pochtenalp**

Short detour to Lauterbrunnen and from here by train to Mürren. The trekking route leads past the Spillbodenalp to the Rotstockhütte. After a short stop for refreshments, you climb the Sefinenfurgge and descend to the Pochtenalp or Griesalp. A spectacular stretch.

DAY5

Griesalp/Pochtenalp -**Kandersteg**

approx. 17 km | 7 hours

Today you tackle the "king's stage" - the ascent to Hohtürli. After a long and steep ascent to 2,843 m, you will be rewarded with a fortifying lunch at the Blüemlisalphütte.

Over the Hohtürli and on the moraines of the Blüemlisalp glacier you then descend to Lake Oeschinen. Continue to Kandersteg (alternative variant from Lake Oeschinen: ride the cable car down to the valley).

Kandersteg – Adelboden

approx. 12 km | 4.5 hours

Take the cable car to Allmenalp, then hike up to the Bonderchrinde. Enjoy the magnificent panoramic view of the surrounding Alpine panorama. Then hike down into the valley to Adelboden.
