











Majorca – Trans Tramuntana

Coastal and mountain hiking on the GR 221

The well-marked hiking trails through the northern part of Mallorca on the "Trans Tramuntana" hiking tour are sure to captivate you. Hikers are drawn to this serene side of the largest Balearic island, where the landscape boasts untamed expanses of grass and rock. This walking holiday follows pilgrimage routes inland, unveiling a side of Majorca that you may not have experienced before.

Known as 'La Luminosa' in Spanish, Mallorca (or Majorca) reveals its hidden treasures, showcasing its best features. Explore the peaceful heart of Mallorca, the rugged Serra de Tramuntana, with trails that wind over rocky terrain and past sun-drenched oak trees. Traverse olive groves to reach picturesque villages adorned with manor houses and castles. Along the way, you'll be treated to magnificent views of the sea and small islands. The idyllic coastal villages offer the perfect blend of sun, beaches, sea, and relaxation, making them a highlight of your journey.

Details about the walking holiday on the Serra de Tramuntana

The Serra de Tramuntana in the northwest of the island of Mallorca is both the path and the destination of the hiking tour. The mountain range has wonderful hiking trails through original vegetation and intact nature.

The highlights of the Majorca walking tour:

- **The pilgrimage routes of Mallorca:** Between Pollença and Lluc you walk on beautiful pilgrimage routes through oak forests and orchards. The destination of the pilgrimage routes is the historic monastery of Lluc, where you even spend a night.
- **With the nostalgic train through orange groves:** You conclude the hiking week in Mallorca with a ride on the nostalgic train "Red Lightning" from Pt. Soller to Palma. Included in the hiking holiday!
- **Mallorca's idyllic facet:** Scenically attractive, wonderfully far and far away from the beaten path - the Serra de Tramuntana shows a completely new face of the Balearic island.

Worth knowing about the hiking tour in northern Majorca

Your hiking holiday in the Serra de Tramuntana begins on the Alcúdia peninsula, more precisely in Port de Alcúdia. Your first hike along the coast with fantastic views of the sea also starts on the peninsula. Over the next few days, you will get to know the lonely, quiet Mallorca a little better every day, until you finally immerse yourself in the hustle and bustle of the island's capital in Playa de Palma.

The mountain hikes are between 10 and 15 kilometres long and require surefootedness and fitness. The paths are sometimes very rocky.

Route summary

Surefootedness and a good basic fitness level are required for tours with walking times of up to 6 hours. That way you get to see Mallorca from a different, excellent side. Paths are in parts quite stony, but easy to tackle with a good pair of walking boots.

Itinerary


DAY 1	Arrival in Pt. Alcúdia	
DAY 2	Coastal hike on the Alcúdia peninsula	approx. 15 km 6 hours
<p>One of the most beautiful hiking trails is between the Bay of Pollença and Alcúdia. You hike along the coastline and climb a dreamy crag. A serpentine path with endless panoramic views takes you over gentle peaks before you reach the historic town of Alcúdia and finally the promenade of Pt. Reach Alcudia.</p> <p> ca. 6 hours  15 km  690 m  820 m</p>		
DAY 3	Pt. Alcúdia – Lluc Monastery	approx. 13 km 4.5 hours
<p>Short transfer to Pollença where you will follow the historic pilgrimage route to Lluc. With the high peaks of the Serra de Tramuntana in mind, hike over the pass past the Puig Tomir. Shady holm oak forests, blooming orchards and rough meadows result in a varied landscape. Connoisseurs hike through the botanical garden in the Lluc monastery.</p> <p> ca. 4,5 hours  13 km  600 m  220 m</p>		
DAY 4	Pilgrimage path along the Cuber reservoir	approx. 15 km 5.5 hours
<p>Morning transfer to the Cuber reservoir, where you will undertake another stage on the pilgrimage route to Lluc. Your path leads high up into the Serra and over the passes down to Lluc. An interesting landscape with high grass, rocks and transitions like in the high mountains lies in front of you. The sunny views of the cliffs and the fertile valleys make this tour the king's stage. Return to the Lluc Monastery for the night.</p> <p> ca. 5,5 hours  15 km  880 m  590 m</p>

Lluc monastery – Pt. Sóller


approx. 12 km | 4.5 hours

You hike along the Cuber reservoir to the Pass de L'Ofre, where a magnificent panoramic view of the peaks of the Serra de Tramuntana awaits you. You follow the switchbacks uphill to the Es Cornador summit, where you can enjoy the distant view over the coast to Palma. On the way to Sóller, follow the well-known panoramic terraced path through the gorge of Biniaraix, one of the most beautiful landscapes of the Tramuntana mountains. Along fragrant orange gardens, you reach the lively centre of Sóller. Take the old streetcar to the coast at Pt. He shall.

Coastal path from Deia to Sóller


approx. 12 km | 5 hours

Transfer to the artist town of Deia. Your hike along the wild and romantic rocky coast in the direction of Sóller starts in the bay of Deia. A varied route awaits you, with great views and numerous quiet places to linger. In the blossoming garden of a finca, high above the valley of Sóller, you can fortify yourself with freshly squeezed orange juice and a wonderful piece of cake before starting your day tour along the beach promenade of Pt. Decide on Sóller.

Pt. Sóller – Playa de Palma

approx. 13 km | 3.5 hours

With the nostalgic train through the valley of the oranges to the bustling capital of Palma. Stroll through the lively streets and to the impressive cathedral before heading along the beach promenade to Playa de Palma. Alternatively, there is a hike to Fornalutx, the most beautiful village in Mallorca. You walk through the green and fertile valley of Sóller along olive and almond gardens and fragrant orange groves.

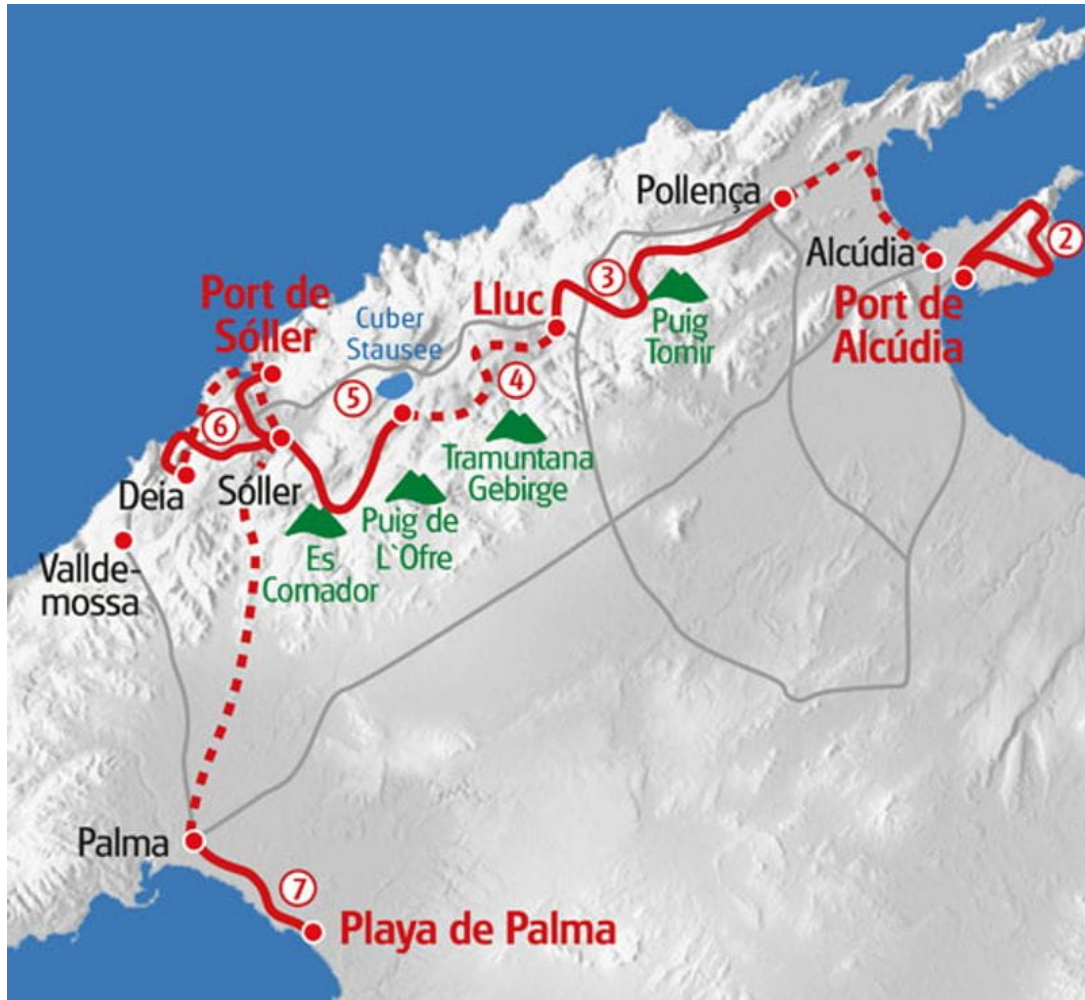
