Details about the cycling holiday from Innsbruck to Vienna

Begin your journey leisurely along the Inn Cycle Path, allowing yourself to be captivated by the awe-inspiring Nordkette mountains rising steeply in the distance. While passing through the Ziller Valley, make a brief stop, for your next destination awaits—the majestic waterfalls nestled in Salzburg's Pinzgau region claimed to be the largest in Europe.

Following the well-trodden path of the popular Tauern Cycle Path, you'll be led past the picturesque Lake Zellersee, ultimately arriving at the world-renowned city of Salzburg. Continuing onward, the trail guides you to Passau, where the paths of the Inn and Danube rivers intersect once again. From here, set forth on the enchanting route of the Danube Cycle Path, which will escort you to the vibrant capital city of Vienna.

The highlights of this Austrian cycling holiday at a glance:

- Krimml Waterfalls: Europe's largest waterfalls located in Krimml await you on this tour. During a short hike along the high-altitude path, you can also admire the roaring masses of water live. But beware, at one point or another it could get a little wet.
- Lake Zeller See: To cool off during your bike tour, dive into Lake Zeller See. If you prefer to get to know the lake from the shore, you can also do an extra lap here and cycle around it once.
- Salzburg: Take enough time to explore the world-famous Mozart city of Salzburg and all its sights such as the cathedral and the fortress. We highly recommend a stroll through the old town along Getreidegasse Road.
- Silent Night Chapel: Every year, millions sing the world-renowned Christmas carol, Silent Night' under the tree. In 1818 the premier took place in the St. Nikolaus church in Oberndorf, better known today as the Silent Night Chapel.
- **Vienna:** There is probably no better destination than the capital Vienna for this tour across Austria. Enjoy the last few hours in imperial Vienna and visit St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Hofburg or Schönbrunn Palace.


Worth knowing about the cycle tour from Innsbruck to Vienna via Salzburg

Itinerary

DAY 1

Arrival in Innsbruck

Welcome meeting and distribution of rental bikes. The renowned historic centre, the ,Golden Roof' or the Bergisel ski jump are world-famous tourist attractions.

DAY2

Innsbruck - Strass/Zillertal

approx. 50 km

Accompanied by the towering Nordkette mountains situated above the saltworks town of Hall with its historic Münzerturm tower to Wattens. Here you can visit the enchanting Swarovski World of Crystals. Along the Inn cycle path past Schwaz (Silver tourist mine) to the ,cyclists' village' of Strass situated at the entrance of the Zillertal-valley.

DAY 3

Strass/Zillertal -Krimml

approx. 25 - 45 km + Transfer

With a view onto the fascinating mountain backdrop of the Zillertaler Hauptkamm with its mountain giants featuring altitudes of more than 3000 metres, it is very enjoyable to cycle along the Zillertal cycle path all the way to Zell, or even a bit further into the renowned Mayrhofen. In the early afternoon, you take the transfer bus via the Gerlospass to Krimml. Already during this transfer, you get to marvel at Europe's largest waterfalls, which you can afterwards also admire ,live' along a high-altitude path.

DAY4

Krimml – Kaprun/Zell am See approx. 60 km

Today's route leads you through the Hohe Tauern national park and the Oberpinzgau region. En route, you are constantly accompanied by snow-covered three-thousand-metre-high peaks. Lush green meadows and cosy little villages take turns and offer a fairy-tale backdrop. In Kaprun, you can then visit the highmountain reservoirs.

DAY 5

approx. 50 km Kaprun/Zell am See – Lofer

We highly recommend you go for a refreshing swim in Lake Zeller See, athletic cyclists can add on an extra loop. Via Maria Alm featuring the renowned pilgrimage church you quickly reach Saalfelden, where you enjoy your lunch break. Other highlights en route to Lofer are the Seisenberg-ravine and the Lamprechtshöhepeak near Weißbach.

DAY 6

Lofer – Salzburg approx. 50 km

During today's tour, you always cycle in the tranquil Saalachtal-valley. Bad Reichenhall situated in the small ,deutsches Eck' will enchant you with Bavarian flair. Now only a short while and you have reached the Mozart city of Salzburg. The culture-rich offerings will amaze you. Please leave plenty of time for a stroll through the historic centre and plan a visit to Mozart's birthplace.

DAY 7

Salzburg – Burghausen approx. 60 km

Oberndorf with its ,Silent Night Chapel' and extensive alluvial forests lead you to Tittmoning. From here you follow the ,Nature Adventure Trail Unterer Inn' until Burghausen. A splendid historic centre and the largest castle complex in Central Europe are the most significant attractions of the town.

D A Y **8**

Burghausen – Schärding approx. 70 km

The Gothic town of Braunau and numerous bird colonies show the way to Obernberg. Reichersberg Abbey invites you for a visit. The little towns along the river Inn appear just like pearls and without doubt one of them is the Baroque town of Schärding with its renowned row of colourful houses called ,Silberzeile'.

D A Y **9**

Schärding – Donauschlinge approx. 55 km

Along the river Inn into the city of three rivers Passau. We recommend a city tour including a visit to the cathedral, home of the largest church organ in the world. Along the river Danube you cycle via Obernzell and Engelhartszell featuring the only Trappists-monastery in Austria through the Donauleiten nature reserve to the ,Schlögener Schlinge'-river loop. A short ferry ride takes you across the Danube to the hotel.

D A Y **10**

Donauschlinge – Enns approx. 70 km

The renowned Danube river loop is one of the many highlights of this cycling holiday. The market towns along the river Danube Aschach, Ottensheim and Wilhering lead you into the provincial capital Linz. You continue to Enns, Austria's oldest town featuring the town square and tower and the town museum ,Lauriacum').

D A Y **11**

Enns – Marbach/Maria Taferl approx. 65 km

Again today you cycle along the river Danube into the glorious little Baroque town of Grein. Here you need to visit the theatre, the maritime museum and Greinburg castle. Through the once-feared Strudengau, you cycle into the Weinviertel area to Marbach or Maria Taferl featuring the pilgrimage church situated high above the Danube.

D A Y **12**

Marbach/Maria Taferl – Vienna

approx. 55 km + Train journey

Melk Abbey greets you and makes a big impression before the marvellous Wachau region with the romantic little wine towns Weißenkirchen, Dürnstein and Krems enchant you. By train, you continue into the capital Vienna offering a multitude of sights.
