Details about the cycling tour around Alsace

This cycling holiday in Alsace includes luggage transport and you will explore Alsace for eight days. The bike tour stops at the most beautiful spots the region has to offer: Strasbourg, Riquewihr, Colmar and Ottmarsheim are just some of the cities where you stay. Pleasantly flat cycle paths with few slopes, idyllic rest areas and mysterious castle ruins.

The highlights of the cycling holiday at a glance


- Alsatian cuisine: The "Cuisine d'Alsace" has a lot to offer, including Choucroute, the Alsatian sauerkraut with pork and sausage, or the classic tarte flambée. The culinary experience is rounded off with quality wines from the region
- Idyllic landscape on the Rhine: The meadows of the Rhine and the hilly landscape of the Weinstrasse exude a feeling of relaxation and tranquillity that you will certainly experience during your bike rides!
- **Colmar:** An authentic French art town with buildings from the fifteenth or sixteenth century. This fairytale village was also the main source of inspiration for the village of Beauty and the Beast

Worth knowing about the Alsace Photobook bike tour

The bike tour starts with your journey to Strasbourg and ends on the eighth day in this largest city of Alsace. In between, there are sporty and active days on the bike, on which you cycle a total of 320 kilometres. Daily stages between 25 and 70 kilometres on easy bike paths - often even through the vineyards. A short stop at one of the excellent wineries is well worth it!

Arrival in Strasbourg

Early arrival in Strasbourg is recommended as the city has more than enough to explore on its own.

You leave Strasbourg via the cycle route along the Rhine-Rhône Canal in a southerly direction.

You drive through villages and along the canal from Marckolsheim to the art city of Colmar. This fairytale village was also the main source of inspiration for the village of Beauty and the Beast. Colmar is an authentic French art town with a rich history dating back to the 8th century. A city walk also starts at Museum d'Unterlinden, which is located opposite the Office du Tourisme. The description of the walk can be purchased for 50 euro cents at the Office du Tourisme. With this city walk, you really don't miss anything about this unique city.

Colmar – Mulhouse approx. 65 km

You say goodbye to Colmar. On beautifully landscaped cycle paths it goes via Neuf-Brisach to Ottmarsheim. It is worth visiting the basilica from the 12th century. You continue your route along the Rhine Canal, which leads you to the centre of Mulhouse.

On cycle paths and via small streets past the open-air museum "Ecomusée d'Alsace". Continue your route at the foot of the Vosges peaks to Guebwiller.
