### Worth knowing about the hiking tour in Bavaria for families

This seven-day tour through Bavaria, begins at Lake Tegernsee and continues to Riederstain, Bad Wiessee, Schliersee, and Spitzingsee. On the fifth day, you and your family will travel by bus to Schliersee and eventually reach the final destination, Bayrischzell. The average walking time ranges from three to four and a half hours, requiring good basic fitness for both adults and kids. If you find it too strenuous, many stages can be shortened using public transport.

# Itinerary

DAY 1	Arrival in Bad Wiessee	
DAY 2	Round trip to Mt. Riederstein	approx. 9 km   3 to 4 hours
<p>Altitude paths with amazing views, to the mountain inn Galaun, then onwards to the little mountain chapel on the rock formation of Mount Riederstein, from where you have a magnificent view down to the lake and the surrounding mountains. Once back on the lake, the Tegernsee brewery inn invites you to a cool beverage, before you return with the Tegernsee ship to Bad Wiessee.</p> <p> ca. 3 to 4 hours      9 km      420 m      450 m</p>		
DAY 3	Bad Wiessee – Schliersee	approx. 16 km   4 to 4.5 hours
<p>You soon reach alpine pastures from Tegernsee via a steep forest trail surrounding the well-known Alpine beer garden Neureuth. After a break with lovely views of the lake, you casually continue your tour to the Gindelalm alp and descend along forest paths and forest roads to Lake Schliersees after the marina you reach the pretty and neat spa park situated directly at the lakeside of Lake Schliersee.</p> <p> ca. 4 to 4,5 hours      16 km      420 m  380 m</p>

4**Round trip to Mt.  
Spitzingsee**approx. 13 km | 3 to 4  
hours

Along the lakeside-adventure-path, you get to Fischhausen. Then along the path, Bockerlbahnweg with numerous info points via the former forest railway, you first walk to the col 'Spitzingsattel' and then onwards to the picturesque Lake Spitzingsee. Walk around this nature idyll before you take a break in the historic chalet, 'Wurzhütte' and then return by bus to Schliersee.

5**Lake Schliersee –  
Bayrischzell**approx. 9 km | 4  
hours

A light and airy cable car ride take you to the summit station on Mount Taubenstein. Then you walk on a high-altitude path with brilliant views of the Rotwandhaus, where you can climb to the peak of the Rotwand if you fancy. Onwards via the picturesque cirque 'Großtiefentaler Kessel' to Lake Soinssee with its idyllic location, then along alpine pastures and flowering meadows to Bayrischzell.

The King-Maximilian path leads you past a waterfall to the Wendelstein-Alp. From there, you walk to the summit with its impressive meteorological observatory and along the panorama-loop-path to the Wendelstein cave with its accessible underground tunnels. After a snack in the panorama-beer garden, you take the cable car back into the valley and casually walk back to Bayrischzell.

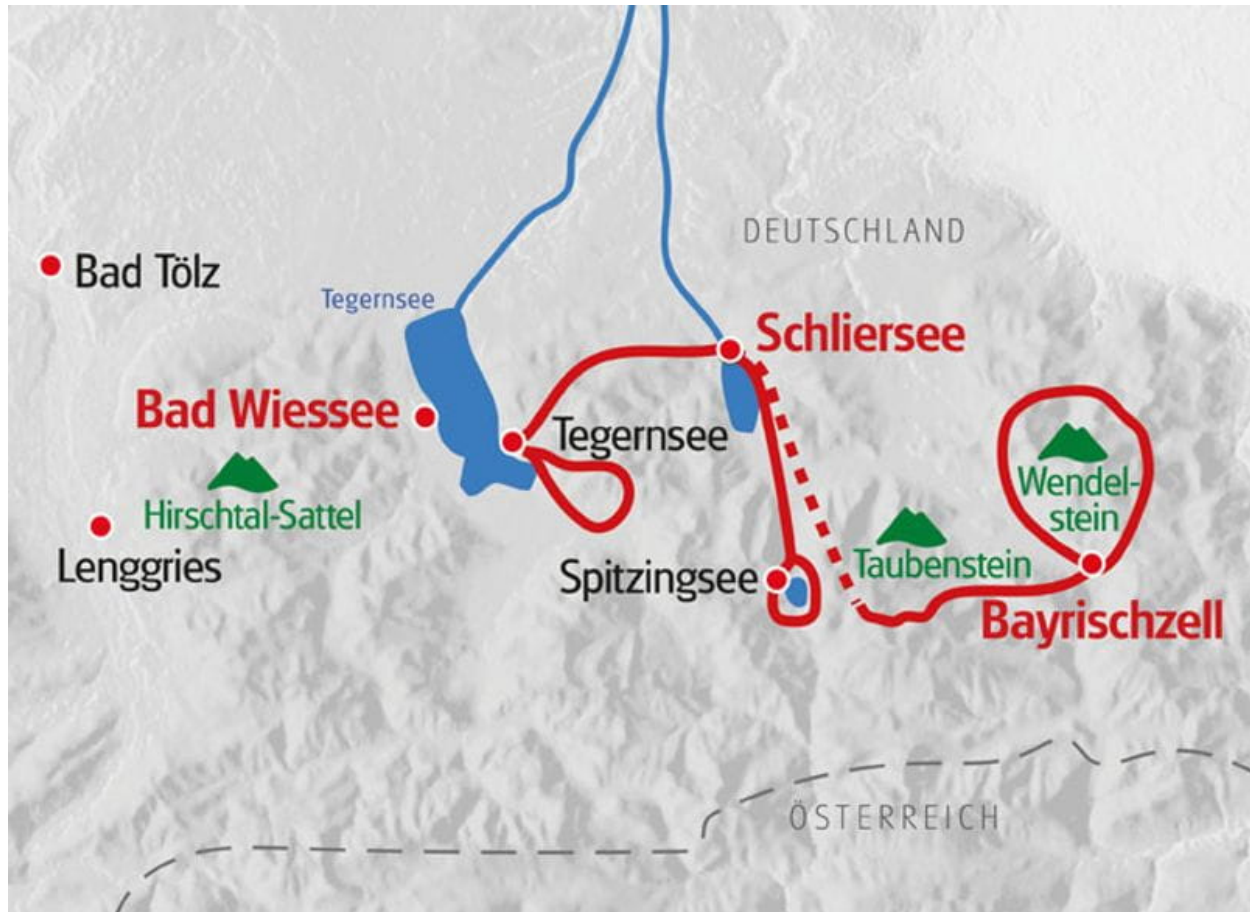

# Route information

Enjoy comfortable and pleasant hikes along well-maintained trails and forest roads. For more challenging elevations, cable cars are available, and segments of the hike can be easily shortened using public transport.

Requirements include basic fitness, with children accustomed to walking for a few hours and having some prior walking experience. The trails mainly traverse meadows, forest tracks, and well-marked paths.

### Arrival / Parking / Departure:

- Arrival by train to Munich, and then by train to Bad Tölz with a journey time of approx. 1 hour.
- Munich airport.
- Parking: limited number of hotel parking spaces free of charge, no reservation possible. There are parking spaces near the hotel free of charge or the public underground car park for approx. EUR 30 per week, no reservation possible.
- Return journey by train from Bayrischzell to Bad Tölz, duration approx. 1.5 hours.

### Important information:

- Tourist tax, if due, is not included in the price
- Train/bus journey from Lake Spitzingsee to Bayrischzell, approx. EUR 5 per person
- Bus journey from Lake Schliersee to Lake Spitzingsee, approx. EUR 2 per person
